

The U.S. House of Representatives recently introduced a bill that is designed to strip victims of asbestos-related diseases of their rights and prevent them from obtaining just compensation. The Furthering Asbestos Claim Transparency Act of 2017 (“FACT Act”) is an open attack on the privacy of asbestos victims and an insult to those individuals whose family members have died or are dying from asbestos-related diseases.

The **FACT Act has nothing to do with transparency and everything to do with letting powerful corporations off the hook** for the injuries they have caused in exposing tens of thousands of veterans, workers, and their families to deadly asbestos. If enacted, the FACT Act will place burdensome and costly reporting requirements on asbestos trusts and will make many asbestos injury lawsuits – including yours – nearly impossible to pursue. The Act will allow the asbestos industry to delay and deny compensation to asbestos victims and their families while requiring asbestos trusts to publicly disclose the personal information of victims of asbestos-related diseases.

This bill could essentially **eliminate the rights of asbestos victims to get justice in our court system**. A vote on the bill is expected very soon. We need to send a strong message to Congress that this bill must be defeated.
