

Two weeks ago, the U.S. House of Representatives introduced a new bill that could essentially **eliminate the rights of all Americans to get justice in our court system** through class actions or multidistrict litigation efforts. Class actions and multidistrict litigations are often the only viable options for injured patients and consumers to level the playing field and seek compensation when they have been harmed by large corporations. A vote on the bill is expected very soon.

Despite its name, Fairness in Class Action Litigation Act of 2017 is **not** fair to you: It is a bill that strips you of your rights while giving clear advantage to powerful corporations that do not want to be held accountable. If this bill becomes law, it will make many plaintiff personal injury lawsuits – including yours – nearly impossible to pursue.

The bill would **make it much easier for big, negligent companies to cause harm** and much more difficult for the people to fight back. We need to send a strong message to Congress that this bill must be defeated.
